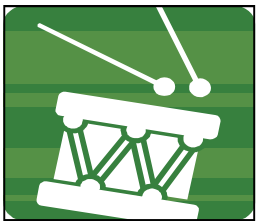


St. Peter's Youth News

Let's Do Breakfast

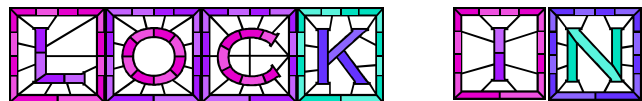

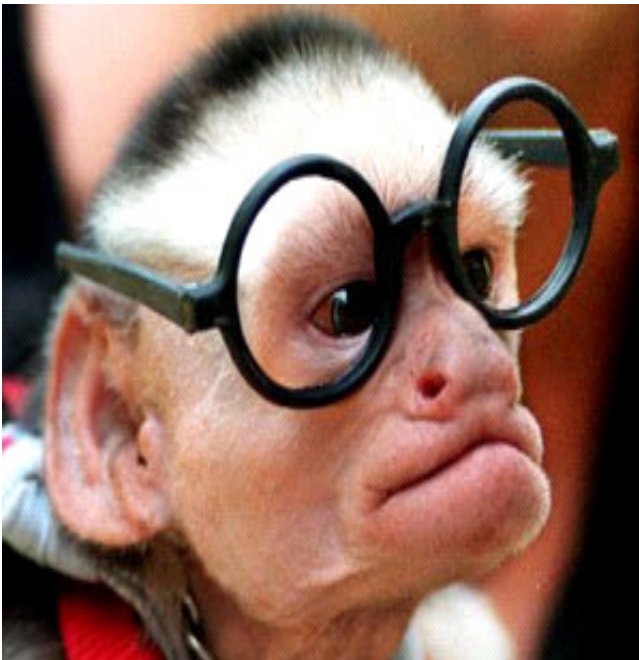
